Support for Large Practices

Practices with 16 or more clinicians under one tax ID number

The Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015 (MACRA) provides direct technical assistance to help these Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) eligible clinicians participate in the Quality Payment Program.

This initiative will help clinicians:

- Select & report on appropriate measures and activities to satisfy requirements of each MIPS performance category – Quality, Improvement Activities, Advancing Care Information and Cost
- Engage in continuous quality improvement
- Optimize health information technology (HIT)
- Evaluate options for joining an Advanced Alternative Payment Model (APM)

Getting started with MIPS Checklist

- Determine whether you have \$30,000 or less in Medicare charges OR 100 or fewer Medicare patients annually. If so, you are exempt from MIPS participation. CMS is mailing letters to all practices notifying them of their exempt status in May 2017
- Make sure your electronic health record is certified by the Office of the National Coordinator (ONC) for Health Information - <https://chpl.healthit.gov/#/search>
- Determine whether you plan to report through claims, electronic health record (EHR), clinical registry, qualified clinical data registry (QCDR) or CMS Web Interface (Formerly known as the GPRO Web Interface)
- Decide which measures and activities best fit your practice - explore the MIPS Measures <https://qpp.cms.gov/measures/performance>
- Decide whether you should report as an individual or with a group
