
### **Written Instructions**

To access Alliant Health Solution's partner portal, you need to set up an account. Follow these steps to do so:


1. To protect your data, we've enabled Multifactor Authentication. Download the Salesforce Authenticator App to your mobile device via the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store before beginning the registration process.
2. Open the Portal Registration page by clicking [here](#) or going to <https://partnerportal.alliantquality.org/CommunitySelfRegister>

5. After creating your password, open the Salesforce Authenticator App on your mobile device. Tap Add an Account. The app will display a two-word phrase.
6. On your computer screen, enter the phrase in the field labeled "Two Word Phrase." Click Connect.



7. In the Salesforce Authenticator App on your mobile device, click Connect.



8. In the Salesforce Authenticator App on your mobile device, click Approve.



8. Once you log into the portal, your default screen is the Home page, which contains discussion threads that all portal users can access and join in on the conversations.
